The Civil War

What Does This Module Include?

This full version of "The Civil War" is a ten-week study on the great conflict that divided the United States over the issues of states' rights and slavery. The study focuses on the way the war itself unfolded: from the adoption of the Anaconda Plan for Northern Victory to Sherman's March to the Sea and the surrender at

Appomattox Courthouse. Each week gives an up-close view of both significant battles and the culture of war and the homefront.

The module includes an easy-to-follow schedule that integrates great reading, website links, DVD suggestions, and intriguing activities that will get kids excited about the technology of the war and the lives of soldiers and folks at home. It also includes amazing, interactive journaling pages that allow your student to create a Civil War Chronicle. The pages allow kids to show what they've learned in fun ways, and contain content that adds even more to your study. The pages focus on major events of the war, significant battles, mapping, the lives of soldiers and home folk, and the war's technology and weapons.

This module is 204 pages in length and is designed to be used in 10 weeks.
