What Does This Module Include?

“Thanksgiving in 1621” is a three-week study on the First Thanksgiving. The study focuses on the voyage aboard the Mayflower, the challenges of establishing a New England colony, and the help of the Wampanoag who lived nearby. Each week gives an up-close view of both the true history of this favorite national story and the realities of the Atlantic voyage and the colony’s first year.

The module includes an easy-to-follow schedule that integrates great reading, website links, DVD suggestions, and intriguing activities that will get kids excited about the history of the First Thanksgiving, and the culture of the Pilgrims and the Wampanoag. It also includes amazing, interactive journaling pages that allow your student to create a Thanksgiving journal and enjoy a variety of family-focused activities. The pages allow kids to show what they’ve learned in fun ways, and contain content that adds even more to your study. Activities and games are designed to add to your family’s enjoyment of the season, and give you fun ways to enjoy your own family celebration on Thanksgiving Day.
